## **Scholarship Information:**

The Taiwanese American Scholarship Fund is focused on helping economically-challenged Taiwanese American youth fulfill their dreams of obtaining higher education. The scholarship is open to high school seniors planning to attend college in the Fall of 2016 and 1<sup>st</sup> year college students continuing their education in the Fall of 2016.

Deadline Extended: 11:59pm - Thursday, March 31, 2016

## **Eligibility:**

- United States citizen or US Permanent Resident (holders of a Permanent Resident Card) AND direct blood descendant of a Taiwanese citizen
- High school senior or 1<sup>st</sup> year college student residing in the United States
- Plan to attend a University or College as a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year student in the Fall of 2016
   (If selected, high school seniors must submit college acceptance letter for verification.)
- Have a minimum cumulative unweighted high school/college GPA of 3.0
- Have a household income at or below the Federal/State/County Low Income Level
   (Must be able to show 2014 or 2015 tax return should applicant be selected for award.)
- The scholarship is open to ALL MAJORS
- Previous award recipients are eligible to apply as long as they meet the eligibility requirements

**All awardees must submit a short YouTube video.** Detailed instructions will be provided to awardees at a later time.

## **Application Requirements:**

- Online Application Form
- Three References
- Official Transcript

The scholarship awards will only be used to cover the cost of attending a University or College.

What is considered cost of attendance varies by institution.
