10 - \$5,000 Scholarships Available for High School Seniors and 1<sup>st</sup> Year College Students Planning to Attend a University/College in the U.S. in the Fall of 2020

## Scholarship Information:

The Taiwanese American Scholarship Fund is focused on helping economically-challenged Taiwanese American youth fulfill their dreams of obtaining higher education. The scholarship is open to high school seniors planning to attend college in the Fall of 2019 and 1<sup>st</sup> year college students continuing their education in the Fall of 2020.

**Deadline:** 11:59pm – Wednesday, March 25, 2020

## Eligibility:

- **United States citizen or US Permanent Resident (holders of a Permanent Resident Card) AND direct blood descendant of a Taiwanese citizen**
- **High school senior or 1<sup>st</sup> year college student residing in the United States**
- Plan to attend a University or College as a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year student in the Fall of 2019 (If selected, high school seniors must submit college acceptance letter for verification.)
- **Have a minimum cumulative unweighted high school/college GPA of 3.0**
- **Have a household income at or below the Federal/State/County Low Income Level** (Must be able to show 2018 or 2019 tax return should applicant be selected for award.)
- The scholarship is open to **ALL MAJORS**

All awardees must submit a short YouTube video. Detailed instructions will be provided to awardees at a later time.

## Application Requirements:

- Online Application Form
- Three References
- Official Transcript

The scholarship awards will only be used to cover the cost of attending a University or College. What is considered cost of attendance varies by institution.
