### SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Taiwanese American Scholarship Fund is focused on helping economically-challenged Taiwanese American youth fulfill their dreams of obtaining higher education. The scholarship is open to high school seniors planning to attend college in the Fall of 2022 and 1st-year college students continuing their education in the Fall of 2022.

### ELIGIBILITY

- **United States citizen or US Permanent Resident (holders of a Permanent Resident Card) AND direct blood descendant of a Taiwanese citizen**
- **High school senior or 1st-year college student residing in the United States**
- Plan to attend a University or College as a 1st or 2nd-year student in the Fall of 2022 (If selected, high school seniors must submit a college acceptance letter for verification.)
- **Have a minimum cumulative unweighted high school/college GPA of 3.0**
- **Have a household income at or below the Federal/State/County Low Income Level** (Must be able to show 2020 or 2021 tax return should the applicant be selected for award.)
- The scholarship is open to **ALL MAJORS**

All awardees must submit a short YouTube video. Detailed instructions will be provided to awardees at a later time.
